

SEX, GENDER AND EXPRESSION

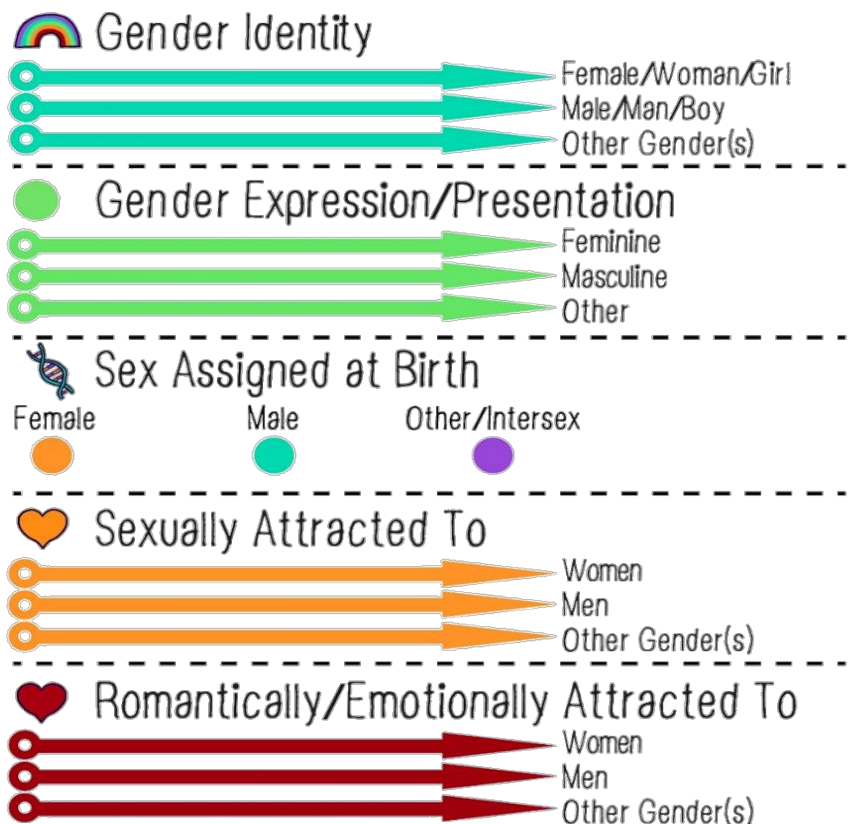
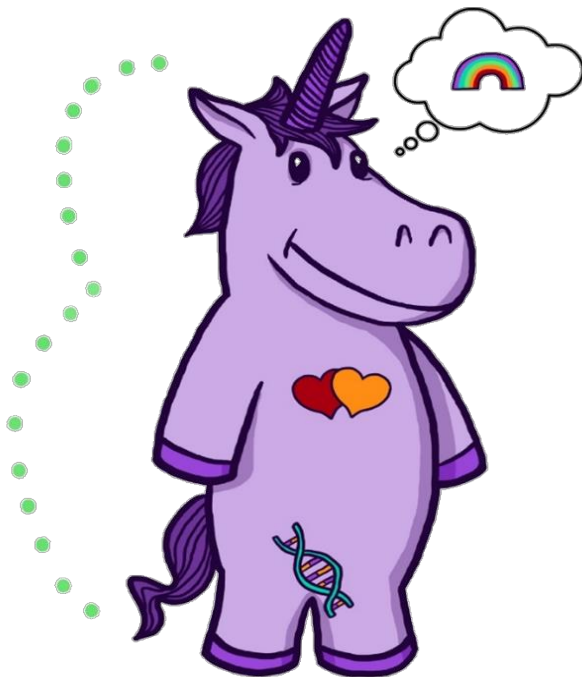
